who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. Vacant posts can be filled at any time by approval of the Committee.

2. A Scrutineer shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

3. The Wessex Cyclo Cross Annual General Meeting shall be held at such a time so that changes from the National Cyclo Cross Commission can be incorporated into Wessex Cyclo Cross and that the proposals for changes to Wessex Cyclo Cross can be considered, and if appropriate agreed upon, so that the next seasons fixture process can be commenced in time for the calendar deadline of the first week in May.

To assist in compiling the Racing Cyclo Cross Calendar, and to give an equal opportunity to past, current and future Promoters, all potential Promoters for the next Season must submit the Event Promotion Tender form by the 30th May preceding the coming Season.

4. Each Affiliated Club is permitted two voting members and each Individual Affiliated Member is permitted one vote at the Annual General Meeting. (The League Officers can only vote as members of their Affiliated Club or as Individually Affiliated Members)

5. Wessex Affiliation fees are –

Clubs and Teams -	£50.00 per Season
Individuals -	£25.00 per Season

Affiliation to be paid before the start of the 3rd Wessex Cyclo Cross Race Event of the Season. If paid after this date, points will only be accrued from the actual payment date.

Affiliation fees are applicable for Junior's, Under 23's, Senior's and Masters.

Youths and Under 12's will automatically be members of the Wessex League.

6. Wessex Race Levies –

Under 12's -	£1.00 per race
Youth -	£1.00 per race
Juniors, Under 23's, Senior's and Masters -	£1.00 per race

BC Levies are as detailed on the BC website and are payable by the Organiser direct to BC.

7. Race entry fees are capped, including all race levies and organisers costs, are set by the Wessex Committee for all races in the Wessex League for Under 16, 14, 12, 10 and 8 racing. For the 2026/2027 Season these are capped at –

Under 16 & 14 -	£10.00
Under 12, 10 & 8 -	£7.00

8. The Rules of Cyclo Cross as prescribed by British Cycling will be inextricably incorporated into Wessex Cyclo Cross.

9. All Wessex events held between the 1st September and the end of February will count towards Wessex points.

The number of point scoring counting events for an individuals or teams score in the Wessex League will be 50% of all the counting Wessex League events plus 2 more rides (rounded up to the next whole number). Except that for Youth and Junior where the number of counting rounds shall be 12 less the total number of national events (currently limited to National Trophy and National Championships).

For the 2026/2027 Season the number of counting events will be –

U23's, Seniors, Veterans

12 Wessex Events, including the SoE divided by 2 equals 6 , rounded up to 6, plus 2 = 8 Counting Events

Youth, Juniors

The number of counting rounds for youth under 14, under 16 and junior riders shall be 12 less the total number of national events (currently limited to National Trophy and National Championships).

So, **12 – 6 = 6 Counting Events** (you can ride more, it is just your best 6 to count)

10. Expenses will be paid to the Commissaire's in accordance with the BC Expense Policy, for mileage and food only, irrespective of how long they are officiating at the Event. Mileage will be paid at £0.40/mile food will be paid up to a maximum of £7.00 per day*, supported by receipts, and will be claimed by using the Wessex Expense Form and sent to the Treasure no later than three weeks after the event. (Expense claims received after three weeks will not be paid.)

* Provided they do not make use of the organisers lunch and refreshments.

Event Organisers will provide all three Commissaire's with Lunch and refreshments.

11. The Event Organisers and Timing Company, as appropriate, to forward to the:

- League Points Secretary: A copy of the results within three days of their event.
- Treasurer: Levy Form and Levies within 7 days of the event.

12. The Commissaire will be neutral and will be appointed by the Wessex Committee, the Commissaire has the right to alter the course to ensure that it complies with the BC Cyclo Cross Rules and that it is safe. Each event will have a minimum of 3 Commissaires.
13. All events will be started by the Commissaire.
14. A Presentation/Podium for the first 5 finishers in each category will take place immediately after the race.
15. The Wessex League colours are Red/Yellow.
16. Prizes Values will be equal in value between genders with-in the same race category, both at League Events and for the Overall League Prizes. There is no requirement or expectation that a Race Organiser will give out any prizes. If prizes are given out, they should not be in the form of cash.

Under 12's / 10's / 8's - Boys & Girls - Wessex Medals for first three places in each category.

17. Points Scoring and Prizes for the Wessex League

Separate Senior/Under 23 Race (Open)

1st = 90 points, 2nd = 87, 3rd = 85, 4th = 84, 5th = 83, 86th = 1 point, and every place after that is awarded 1 point.

Only Wessex League affiliated riders score points, therefore if the winner is a non-affiliated rider, then the 90 points go to the first finishing Wessex League affiliated rider.

Any Rider riding Open only League Races will only score Open Points (no separate points will be awarded for any other categories.)

A Team prize will be given for a team of 3 riders, the three riders final points totals are added together. Riders must race under the Team name that they are affiliated to for Cyclo Cross as notified to BC.

Juniors will not be allowed to ride the Open and Under 23's Race, unless dispensation is granted by BC.

Masters can ride the Open race but will only score Open Points. (It should be noted that BC Ranking Points will not be available for Masters riding in Open Races if there is a separate Masters race on the race programme for the day.)

Separate Women/Junior/Master 40 Open/Master 50 Open/Master 60/Master 70 Open Races

1st = 90 points, 2nd = 87, 3rd = 85, 4th = 84, 5th = 83, 86th = 1 point, and every place after that is awarded 1 point.

Only Wessex League affiliated riders score points, therefore if the winner is a non-affiliated rider, then the 90 points go to the first finishing Wessex League affiliated rider.

Juniors and Master 40 (V40, V45, V50, V55, V60, V65, V70 and overall Master) will score points according to where they finish within their respective category.

Women will score points, irrespective of which Woman's subcategory they are in, 1st = 90 points, 2nd = 87, 3rd = 85, 4th = 84, 5th = 83, 86th = 1 point, and every place after that is awarded 1 point. The sub-subcategories for the Women, Women Master 40, Women Master 50 and Women Master 70 will be awarded in the Woman's League.

A Team prize will be given for a team of 3 riders, the three riders final points totals are added together. Riders must race under the Team name that they are affiliated to for Cyclo Cross as notified to BC. Team prizes will be awarded for Master 40 Open, Master 50 Open, Master 60/70 Open and Women (across all categories)

Under 12 Racing

There is no League for the Under 12's.

End of Season Medals will be awarded, please see below.

Youth League

All as the Senior Open League

Youth Riders will score points according to where they finish in their Under 14, or Under 16 categories, Open and Girls will be separated in each category.

A Team prize will be given for a team of 2 or 3 riders, as detailed below, the two or three rider's final points totals are added together. Riders must race under the Team name that they are affiliated to for Cyclo Cross as notified to BC. Team prizes will be awarded for Under 16's and Under 14's.

All Leagues

Tied Riders

In the event of a tie the rider with the overall best place on count back will be awarded the higher overall finishing position in the final League Table of the Season. Count Back will be based on the 'head-to-head' rides of the riders concerned, so if rider 'A' has beaten rider 'B' 4 times, and rider 'B' has beaten 'rider 'A' 3 times, rider 'A' will be awarded the higher final position. In the event of a tie, on count back the final position will be based on the last time the two riders raced each other.

Regional Championships

If the Championship Race is also declared a full Wessex Race (this will be announced at the beginning of the Season), all riders will score points as normal. If it is not declared a full Wessex Race, average points will be awarded if the rider finishes the race.

All riders who ride and finish their respective Regional Championships, other than stated above, will be awarded average points, based on their best three rides, this does not include any 90 points accrued for race organisation or the like, prior to the Championships (if a rider has only ridden one, or two races, it will be the average of these).

Officials and Helpers Points

Maximum points will be awarded to -

Riders who Organise, act as course director, Lap Score or Commissaire for a maximum of three events in any one Season will score maximum points as below –

Officiate one race =	90 points, to activate them ride and finish two league events.
Officiate two races =	180 points, to activate them ride and finish in four league events.
Officiate three races =	270 points, to activate them ride and finish in six league events.

Or some other special circumstances that are agreed upon by the Committee.

Any rider who gives up their ride for the day and assists, in any way (marshalling, setting out/packing up the course, car parking, signing on and the like), in the promotion of an event will be given average points,

based on their best three rides, this does not include any 90 points accrued for race organisation or the like, prior to the event (if a rider has only ridden one, or two races, it will be the average of these).

All claims for Organisers & Helpers Points must be submitted to the League Secretary within 2 weeks of the event.

Single Bike Category

Each League will recognise a 'Single Bike' category, whose rules will be –

- Must pre-register before the season starts.
- Ride one bike during the race
- No washing of bike during the race
- No technical assistance during the race

These rules will be self-policed – the Commissaires or other officials will not monitor compliance or adjudicate on any disputes.

One Bike category riders will be identified on the league tables.

Prizes/certificates may be awarded at the end of the season at the discretion of the committee.

18. Gridding is a Wessex League requirement to allow for a safe release of riders at the start of the race.

To facilitate the Gridding process the Race Organiser must supply entry information to the Chief Commissaire (or their representative), by 22.00hrs, on the evening following the closing of on-line entries. This must be the Raw Data in .CSV format.

- Gridding will be based on a riders' best 3 results from their last 5 Wessex League results.
- Riders without Wessex League results will be gridded based on their percentile results from other Cyclo-Cross races, if available on the British Cycling website. These are compared to Wessex rider's percentile results when placing them on the grid. If no results are available, the rider will be placed at the back of the grid.
- Gridding will include last seasons' results in the last 5 races unless the rider has changed category. Riders changing category will have an adjustment applied to their previous results for their first race in the new category. For further details please refer to the Wessex CX website.
- Gridding for U14 Open & Girls, U16 Open & Girls, Open Senior/U23/Junior/M40 and Women Junior/U23/Senior/Masters will be based on finishing positions for the combined races.
- Riders are responsible for ensuring their entry data is correct – registration and entry details must match the details of their British Cycling Membership to ensure the correct gridding position. Corrections will not be made after the 4th Round, any data errors after this time may have a detrimental effect on the riders gridding position.

19. For the final lap of each race a Back Marker wearing a Hi-Viz vest, will follow the last rider. No riders practicing on the course will overtake the Back Marker.

20. The closing day for on-line entries to Wessex League events will be midnight on the previous Monday for Saturday events, and midnight on Tuesday for Sunday events.

Paul Coates Trophy - Awarded to the rider, who in the opinion of the Wessex Committee, has achieved meritorious result/set of results in their Season's performance, either with-in Wessex or Nationally or Internationally.

Stephen Coates Trophy -Awarded to the rider, Senior or older, who has ridden and finished in the most Cyclo Cross races in the Season, which must include all the Wessex Events.

Making a Difference Trophy – Awarded to a League Organiser, Official or Rider who in the opinion of the Wessex Committee has made a significant contribution to Wessex Cyclo Cross in the previous Season/Seasons.

This is to be decided by the previous 3 winners (provided they are still active in the Wessex League) and should not be awarded twice to the same person, for the same role.

Awards will be made on the basis of one award for every five riders who have completed 5 rounds.

One cash prize per rider, highest awarded, more than one medal can be won. Team prizes will be in addition.
